

Mid-Columbia Senior Softball Association Privacy Policy

Introduction

Mid-Columbia Senior Softball Association (MCSSA) respects each individual's right to personal privacy. We will collect and use information through our website only in the ways disclosed in this statement. This statement applies solely to information collected at MCSSA's website.

Part I. Information Collection and Security

MCSSA only collects information on our website submitted by registered users. Such information may include user-submitted information for participation in the league or events. The information is collected by the voluntary submittal of such by registered users.

Additionally, the MCSSA may post pictures on our website or social media accounts. During player registration, we ask each player to sign a photo release giving MCSSA permission to post pictures.

MCSSA's website employs the use of "cookies". A cookie is a small text file that our web server places on a user's computer hard drive to be a unique identifier. Cookies enable MCSSA to track usage patterns and deliver customized content to users. Our cookies do not collect personally identifiable information.

MCSSA does not divulge any personally identifiable information about registered users or MCSSA members to outside parties for any reason (with the exception of a request made for such information [which is legally warranted and presented in person] by an official law enforcement official or agency).

Part II. Information Usage

The information collected by MCSSA is used for the purposes of this website only. Registered users may receive additional announcements from us about site news, events, private messages, uploaded photos, forum posts and web site updates. Out of respect for the privacy of our registered users, we present the option to not receive these types of communications.
